ORDER:

The Government in their orders first read above issued orders sanctioning the project proposals of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University at a cost of Rs.1006.29 lakhs for implementation of Agricultural Mechanisation in Tamil Nadu. Out of this sanctioned amount of Rs.1006.29 lakhs, an amount of Rs.772.98 lakhs was sanctioned towards distribution and introduction of Agricultural Machinery through incentives by the Agricultural Engineering Department as indicated below:-
