Weather forecast for next five days (09.10.2021 to 13.10.2021)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Nagapattinam district, the sky will be moderately cloudy. Rainfall is expected from 09.10.2021 to 13.10.2021. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 33 °C and Minimum temperature is expected to be 23 °C to 24 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 95 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10-12 km per hour and the wind direction will be west south west.

Cotton		Due to prevailing weather condition there are chances of cotton green leaf hopper infestation. To control spray thiamethoxam 25 WG 0.6 gram/litre or imidacloprid 17.8 SL 0.6 ml/litre
Rice	Main field	The pravelling weather condition To control the Thrips damage in transplanted rice, apply Thiamethxam 25WG @ 40g/ acre.
Cattle	Cow	Due to the onset of rainfall farmers are advised to fumigate the shed with Notchi leaves to prevent fly attack.
