Weather Summary/Alert:

Average relative humidity (morning & evening), maximum temperature and minimum temperature may be expected around (70.0% & 55.0%), 38.0°C and 26.0°C respectively. The rainy clouds may appear. | RICE | Due to prevailing weather condition leaf folder infestation identified in paddy crop. To manage the leaf folder Release Trichogramma chilonis @5 cc (1,00,000/ha) thrice at 37, 44 and 51 days. |
| | Early varieties have to be harvested at 10 to 11 months age and mid-season varieties at 11 to 12 months age. Harvest the cane at peak maturity. Cut the cane to the ground level for both plant and ratoon crops. |

| SUGARCANE | Spray sugarcane booster 1,1.5, and 2 kg / acre at 45, 60 and 75 days after planting respectively in 200 litres of water with adequate quantity of wetting agent. Benefits: Enhances cane growth and weight, Improves inter nodal length, Improves cane yield up to 20 per cent, Improves sugar content and Increases drought tolerance. |
| UKKA/ LADVEINGER | Prevailing weather is favorable for shoot and fruit borer incidence in bhendi. To control remove the affected terminal shoot showing boreholes. Install pheromone trap@ 5 nos./ac or spray azadirachtin 1.0% EC 3.0 ml/lit or emamectin benzoate 5 % SG 4.0g/10 liter. |

| BRINJAL | Prevailing weather is favorable for shoot and fruit borer incidence in brinjal. To control remove the affected terminal shoot showing boreholes. Install pheromone trap@ 5 nos./ac or spray azadirachtin 1.0% EC 3.0 ml/lit or emamectin benzoate 5 % SG 4.0g/10 liter. | |
| COCONUT | Coconut Tonic: Root feeding of the tonic @ 200 ml / palm twice a year at six months interval. Benefits: Increases chlorophyll content and greenness of leaves, Improves photosynthetic efficiency of leaves, Decreases button shedding, Increases number and size of nuts, Increases nut yield up to 20 per cent, Increases longevity and vigour of the palm, Imparts resistance to pests, diseases and environmental stresses. | |
| BANANA | Light to heavy rainfall with wind will expected in forthcoming days so farmers are advised to save the banana crop by using stacking method with casuarina poles. | |
| BANANA | Banana cultivating farmers are advised to earth up the soil at bi-monthly intervals, will facilitate the better establishment of banana plants. De suckering should be done carefully at monthly intervals. The dry and diseased leaves have to be removed and burned to control the spread of leaf spot diseases. | |
