## Veterinary College and Research Institute, Namakkal

VCRI, Namakkal, the second veterinary college in Tamil Nadu was started as a constituent unit of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore on 14.06.1985, to augment the human resources and for the betterment of poultry farmers. It later became a constituent unit of India's first veterinary university, the TANUVAS on 20.09.1989. The college has been functioning in an extensive and scenic campus of 500.18 acres at Ladduvadi village, 7 km south to Namakkal town.

The college is offering undergraduate course in veterinary and animal sciences with annual intake of 80 students. MVSc programme was started on 25.10.1993 in six departments inculding Poultry Science and at present, 23 departments are offering PG programme. Doctoral Programme was offered from 1995-96 in two departments including Poultry Science and at present, 17 departments are offering PhD programme.

Apart from teaching, this institute is diverting maximum attention in research activities to meet the growing demands of the farming community. So far 28 schemes to the tune of 225,97 lakhs were sanctioned by ICAR, Central silk board, Govt. of Tamil Nadu, etc.

A livestock and poultry farm complex was started to impart teaching and hands-on-training to the UG and PG students, training to the needy farmers and supplying superior germplsam to the progressive farmers. The poultry farm complex was started on 02.01.1992 with number of different poultry species. At present, modern poultry house for White Leghorn, Japanese quail, crossbred chicken, guinea fowl, turkey and other fancy chicken and a hatchery unit have been established. Recently, environmentally controlled broiler house, emu and ostrich units are added in the poultry farm complex for instructional and demonstration purposes. Three unique hybrids, i.e. Namakkal Quali-1 (meat type), Namakkal Gold quail (layer type) and Namakkal Chicken-1 were evolved in the Department of Poultry Science.

Animal Feed Analytical and Quality Assurance Laboratory (AFAQAL), Poultry Disease Diagnosis and Surveillance Laboratory (PDDSL) and Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) are also functioning in VCRI Campus to cater the needs of livestock and poultry farming community of this region.

The college has been accredited by the ICAR, New Delhi in the year 2001. The "Udyog Excellance Award" to the institution was awarded for the outstanding achievement through economic and social development by the international institute of Education and Management. An ISO 9001: 2000 certification was awarded to the institute from the year 2004-2006. The institute celebrated its silver jubilee Year during 2009-10.



## Dear Colleagues

### Venue

Tamil Nadu stands second both in egg and broiler production and contributes about 18 per cent of total egg and broiler production of our country. Namakkal is the important egg producing poultry pocket in Tamil Nadu. The current population of egg laying birds in Namakkal is around 45 million with a daily egg production of 30 million. The Palladam - Coimbatore belt of Tamil Nadu is well known for broiler production with a capacity of five million birds per week. The allied industries like hatchery, poultry breeder farm, feed mill and pharmaceuticals related to poultry are well developed in Namakkal. More than 1000 entrepreneurs such as feed manufacturers, chicks and medicine marketing organizations, hatcheries apart from poultry farmers are engaged in this region.

The Namakkal zone has tropical semi-arid type of climate with below normal rainfall. The weather is hot (30 – 35°C) with occasional rainfall during the month of October.

Kolli hills and Yercaud are the nearest hill resorts. Temple of Lord Anjaneya in Namakkal and Lord Ranganathar in Trichy are of historical and famous temples.

## Theme

Poultry Industry in India is a vibrant fast growing and dynamic subsector of agriculture and has been recognized as a vital sector for sustainable employment. generation and income that ensures food security through egg and meat. India ranks third in poultry egg and meat production in the World and the industry grows at 8 to 15 per cent per annum. However, poultry produced in India are mainly utilized for domestic purpose and for sustainable growth of the industry, the attention should also be focused on export of poultry products and import of poultry related resources to minimize the cost of production. Value addition of poultry meat and egg products along with issues related with exim policy should be addressed to improve the global trade of poultry in India. Hence the theme of IPSACON 2014 is proposed as "Poultry Production for Global Trade"
