INVITATION FOR PAPERS

Research papers / abstracts thereof on any aspect of meat science and technology with relevance to the theme of the seminar are invited from academics from universities, scientists, experts from industry, postgraduate research scholars and students for presentation in the National Seminar. It is tacitly assumed that the findings being sent has not been presented or published elsewhere before. Abstracts received will be scrutinised by a committee and those considered suitable will be selected for either oral or poster presentation.

Abstracts limited to 300 words, typed in 12 font size (Arial, MS word) with 1.5 line spacing may be sent by email (amstcon14@gmail.com) as an attachment on or before 24.11.2014. Confirmation for selected papers for oral and poster presentation will be sent by email on 01.12.2014. Posters should be 850 mm (breadth) x 1200 mm (length).

THEME OF THE SEMINAR

Theme of the seminar is drawn from the need to have a holistic view of the challenges faced by the meat industry from the perspective of education and

research, to facilitate development of solutions to ameliorate them and also exchange ideas about consumers' perception of meat and meat products. The seminar has been conveniently classified into the following thematic areas:

- Meat processing and preservation
- Meat quality and safety
- Meat plant byproducts and environment
- Meat Bio-technology
