services to humanity and also briefed about various new technologies like protray vegetable seedling production, precision farming technologies in vegetable cultivation and roof gardening for improving sustainable income and encouraging villagers people to go in for organic farming. Dr.Hari. Vijayaraghavan, Professor (Crop Physiology) and Dr.N.Natarajan, Professor (Seed Science and Technology) felicitated. They emphasifed the global warming and its effect on agriculture and the importance of growing trees and seed storage technologies. During the Special Camp, various activities like village statistics collection, awareness on bank services, central and state government schemes for farmers, blood and organ donation, global warming, crime against women and children, ill effects of excessive usage of chemical pesticides, environmental protection were conducted for the benefit of village people.
