Forecast for next five days: 23.08.2023 to 27.08.2023

- During the next five days, light rain will be expected except on 26th August. The temperature range is expected to be around 26-34°C. Relative humidity range is expected to be around 50-80%. The wind speed is expected to be 18-20 km per hour and the wind will be mostly from south south west direction.
- * Rainfall (3.70 mm), maximum temperature (33.13°C) and minimum temperature (23.84°C) will be normal from 27th August to 02nd September.

	Green algae	To avoid the growth of green algae in paddy fields, Copper Sulphate @ one Kg in muslin cloth may be placed in the outlet of bore water irrigated to the field.			
Rice	Maximum tillering Stage	 → To manage rice leaf folder release <i>Trichogramma chilonis</i> 5cc (1,00,000/ha) at 37, 44, 51 days after planting. → Avoid excess application of nitrogen fertilizers. → Setup light trap to attract adult moths. → Setup T- shaped bird perches for predatory birds to control these pests. Apply cartaphydrochloride 50% SP @ 2g/l or flubendiamide 20 WG @ 0.25 g/l or thiamethoxam 25 WG @ 0.2 g/l. 			
Cotton	Maturity stage	The incidence of mealy bug is noticed in cotton. To manage mealy bug, fish oil rosin soap @ 25 g/litre of water or Neem oil 2 % or NSKE 5% or Buprofezin 25 SC @ 2ml/l or Profenophos 50 EC @ 2 ml /litre may be used. To control the wilt, wet the root zone of the affected plants as well as the surrounding healthy plants in circle with either Carbendazim @ 1 g/lit or Trifloxystrobin+Tebuconazole @ 0.75 g/litre.			

SMS: Postpone irrigation as light rain is expected for the next few days.
