Weather forecast for next five days (23.08.2023 to 27.08.2023)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Tiruvarur district, the sky will be clear. Light rainfall is expected on 23.08.2023, 24.08.2023 and 27.08.2023. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 36 - 38 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 - 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 14 - 16 km per hour. The wind direction will be south south west.
