Chances of Rather heavy rain on 11, 12 Oct & Moderate rain during 13, 14, 15 Oct. SMS Maximum temperature would be in the range of 35°C to 36°C and the minimum temperature would be between 24°C - 25°C. Cloudy sky will appear for the next five **Advisory** days. Wind expected with the speed of 4-5 Kmph from, Southeast & South directions.

## **General Advisory:**

Heavy rain is likely to occur at isolated places over the district on 11 & 12 October 2023. Farmers are advised to act swiftly to repair the water channels, farm ponds and other water bodies to harvest the rain water. During these days farmers are advised to avoid irrigation, intercultural operations and application of plant protection measures to the standing crops, provide adequate drainage facilities in the fields to avoid water stagnation due to heavy rainfall, do not allow the animals to grazing outside, standing near the trees or electric poles & provide safe shelter.

#### Weather Based Agro-Advisories: (Banana, Groundnut & Animal Husbandry).

### Banana:

It is important to apply micronutrients to Banana crops, planted in garden land, spraying of Plantozyme (a) 2ml/litre of water is recommended. Similarly, Acid lime and Zinc Sulphate (a) 5gm/litre of water can also be sprayed at this stage. Spraying should be done only on non-rainy days.

### Groundnut:

To increase the flower retention and pod filling in Groundnut. Farmers are advised to give two sprays of Groundnut rich @ 5kg/ha in 500 litres of water (for each spray). The first spray, at 35 days after sowing and the second spray at 45 days after sowing. Spraying should be done only on non-rainy days.

#### Animal Husbandry:

Due to the prevailing weather conditions, the Enterotoxaemia disease may affect the Goats. The main symptom of the disease is sudden death in young growing kids. Mucous diarrhoea may also be seen during death.

To prevent this disease, do not feed on young grass,

Allow the goats to graze one hour after the sunshine.

Vaccinate the animals once a year before the onset of monsoon.
