Weather forecast for next five days (07.10.2023 to 11.10.2023)

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Ariyalur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. Light to moderate rainfall is expected on 07.10.2023 to 11.10.2023. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 35 – 36 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 25 - 26 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 82 - 86 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 64 - 68 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 12 – 14 km per hour. The wind direction will be south west.
