Weather Summary and forecast for Nagaipattinam district

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Nagaipattinam district, the sky will be clear. Light drizzling expected on No rainfall expected coming five days. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 33 - 35 $^{\circ}$ C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 - 25 $^{\circ}$ C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 - 90 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 12 – 14 km per hour. The wind direction will be north east.
