### **Weather Summary and forecast for Thanjavur district**

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Thanjavur district, the sky will be clear. Light drizzling expected on 28.02.2024. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 34 - 35 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 24 - 25 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 90 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 - 50 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10 - 14 km per hour. The wind direction will be north east.

<b>Crop</b>	<b>Stage</b>	<b>Advisory</b>
Sesame	Sowing	Sesame varieties suitable for Masipattam are TMV 4, VRI 1 and TMV 7.
Pulses	Blackgram	In rice fallow black gram, spray DAP (2%) + KCl (1%) solution on morning or evening at flower initiation and another at 15 days interval. Alternatively “pulse wonder” at 5.0 kg/ha can be sprayed during flower initiation.
Pulses	Blackgram	In the rice fallow blackgram, powdery mildew disease would be more pronounced due to dew in morning time. For the management of powdery mildew disease, spray carbendazim 100 g/ac or wettable sulphur 1 kg/ac.
Cattle	Cow	Due to increase in day temperature avoid grazing in hot hours of the day.
