Weather Summary and forecast for Karur district

According to district level forecast issued by India Meteorological Department for Karur district, the sky will be moderate cloudy. No rainfall expected coming five days. Maximum temperature is expected to be around 31 - 32 °C and minimum temperature is expected to be around 19 - 21 °C. Morning relative humidity is expected to be around 80 - 90 percent and evening relative humidity is expected to be around 40 percent. Average wind speed is expected to be around 10 - 12 km per hour. The wind direction will be east.
