Forecast Summary:

As per District level forecast issued by the IMD for Nilgiris district, sky will be cloudy. Very heavy to light rainfall is expected for the next five day. Maximum temperature will be around 12-16°C. Minimum temperature will be around 9-19°C. Morning relative humidity will be around 90-100% and evening relative humidity will be around 90%. Wind speed is to be around 14-16 km per hour.

Weather Warnings (Valid Till 08:30 IST of the next day)

First day (28.05.2024) -Extremely Heavy Rain; Thunderstorms & Lightning, Squall etc; Strong Surface Winds, second day (29.05.2025), third day (30.05.2025) & fourth day (31.05.2025) -very Heavy Rain; Thunderstorms & Lightning, Squall etc; Strong Surface Winds-

Likely impacts of weather warnings on Agriculture and associated Agromet advisories

i. Provide drainage facility. ii. Postpone the intercultural / plant protection activities such as fertilizer and pesticide application until the rain stops.

General Advisory:

Management of seedborne diseases Seeds can be treated with Trichodermaasperellum @ 4g/kg or Bacillus subtilis @ 10g/kg to manage seed borne pathogens. Further, soil testing has to be done before any cropping programme.

SMS Advisory:

All Crops i. Provide drainage facility. ii. Postpone the intercultural / plant protection activities such as fertilizer and pesticide application until the rain stops.

	Garlic • Nutrient and disease management • Foliar application of water- soluble micronutrient mixture (@ 0.5 g/liter of water during 30, 45 and 60 days after planting may be done to increase the garlic bulb yield. spray may be given during rain free period.
BANANA (Vegetative)	Banana: i) Provide support to 5 months old trees using wooden poles. ii) Provide drainage facility and avoid fertilizer and pesticide application. iii) Removal and destruction of decaying and rotten leaves

Likely impacts of weather warnings (General)

Livestock: Damage from thunderstorms with very heavy to light. Cattle can become infected with monsoon diseases.

Impact based advisories (General)

Livestock: i) Protect your animals from lightning and thunderstorm. ii) Do not allow the animals to graze outside. iii) Don't tie the animals to the electric poles and under trees. iv) In consultation with the local veterinarian, vaccinate your animals against seasonal diseases.
