Average wind speed is expected to be around 16 - 24 km per hour and the wind directions will be from west south west direction.

Ge	neral	Since slight and light rainfall is expected, irrigate the field as		
		and when required.		
Rice	Nursery	Roots of 18 to 22 days of old young seedlings need to be dipped in biofertilizers (1 kg or 125 ml of each <i>Azospirillum</i> and phosphobacteria mixed in 40 litre of water and dipped) for 15 to 30 minutes before transplanting.		
Cotton	Vegetative	Prevailing weather condition favours shedding of buds and squares in cotton. To prevent this spray 40 ppm NAA at 60 and 90 days after sowing.		
Sugarcane	Vegetative	Considering weather conditions, detrashing and propping of five months old sugarcane is recommended.		
Coconut		Considering optimum weather condition, root feeding of coconut tonic @ 200 ml / palm can be done.		
Banana		Provide support with wooden poles to avoid lodging of tree due to wind.		
Cattle	Cow	Farmers are advised provide sufficient mineral mixture to nourish the cattle health.
