About ICAR-CPCRI

The ICAR-Central Plantation Crops Research Institute (CPCRI), established in 1916 and headquartered at Kasaragod, Kerala, is a premier institute under the Indian Council of Agricultural Research. Its mandate crops are coconut, arecanut, cocoa, and palmyrah.



The institute has regional stations at Kayamkulam (Kerala) and Vittal (Karnataka), research centres at Kidu (Karnataka), Mohitnagar (West Bengal) and Kahikuchi (Assam), and also hosts the International Coconut Gene Bank for South Asia. Research is organized under five divisions—Crop Improvement, Crop Production, Crop Protection, Physiology & Biochemistry, and Social Sciences—with strong programmes in post-harvest technology and value addition. ICAR-CPCRI also coordinates the All India Coordinated Research Project on Plantation Crops through 28 centers in 14 states, runs two Krishi Vigyan Kendras (Kasaragod and Alappuzha in Kerala), and offers incubation, and entrepreneurship support. With advanced labs, nurseries, germplasm collections, and extension programmes, CPCRI continues to lead R&D in plantation crops.

Background

Scientific knowledge always empowers the cultivators and entrepreneurs to take right decisions for realizing higher yield and income. Over the decades, CPCRI has evolved into a centre of excellence for plantation crops research, combining crop improvement, production technologies, crop protection, post-harvest value addition, and socio-economic studies. Its work has contributed significantly to making India the global leader in coconut and arecanut production. Five different training programmes are being offered for imparting systematic knowledge and skill to the interested and aspiring individuals in science-based plantation crops.
