VC's VISIT TO CORNELL UNIVERSITY, USA



A team of officials and faculty from TNAU headed by Vice-Chancellor Prof. C. Ramasamy visited Cornell University, USA during September 12-14, 2007. During the visit, the delegation discussed the proposal to offer dual degree programs in Food Science and Technology and Biotechnology at post graduate

level by these two institutions. In this regard, the Vice-Chancellor had a meeting with Dr. Henry Susen, Dean, College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Cornell University and other officials. Details regarding course credits to be offered at Cornell University and TNAU were discussed. The proposal will be

placed for approval by the committees of the respective University for approval and implementation from the coming academic year. Besides, the delegation discussed with Ms. Janet McCue, Director, Mann Library, Cornell University on linkages between libraries in TNAU and Mann Library and also to integrate the literature available in various campuses of TNAU. Two faculties from TNAU were given intensive training on the facilities available in Mann Library and the representative from Mann Library will visit TNAU to provide suggestions to improve the facilities in TNAU. Further, the team had discussion with Director and faculty. Departments of Food Science, Applied economics and Plant Breeding and Genetics, Cornell University, USA. The Vice-Chancellor delivered a lecture "Challenges and opportunities in Indian Agriculture" to the faculty and students of Cornell University.
