TNAU conducts ICAR Short course on "Agribusiness, Market Intelligence and Block chain

The Directorate of Agribusiness Development organized a ten days short course on "Agribusiness, Market Intelligence and Block chain" at the Directorate of Agribusiness Development, TNAU, Coimbatore from 30.11.2022 to 9.12.2022. This programme is sponsored by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi. About 19 participants of State Agricultural Universities, Veterinary Universities and affiliated agricultural colleges from Karnataka, Maharashtra, Pondicherry, Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu etc. are participating and around 35 resource persons as course experts are nominated from TNAU, Amrita University Coimbatore and industrial firms such as M/s Farm Again India Pvt. Dr. D. Suresh Kumar, Director (CARDS) and Dr. N. Venkatesa Palanichamy, Dean (Agriculture) delivered the felicitation address.
